# Overview of ERAS

The Electronic Residency Application Service (ERAS®) **streamlines the residency application process** for residency and fellowship applicants, their Designated Dean's Offices, Letter of Recommendation (LoR) authors, as well as Program Directors



*Applicant applies to residency and fellowship program(s)*



*ERAS sends the application and supporting documents to the program(s)*



*Programs receive applications and documents via PDWS*

<b>PDWS</b> (Program Director's Workstation)	<b>Programs</b> (Residency and Fellowship) – GME, Directors, Coordinators, Reviewers, and Interviewers
<b>LoRP</b> (Letter of Recommendation) Portal	<b>Authors</b> – NOT hospital members in advising roles, NOR medical school staff supporting application process

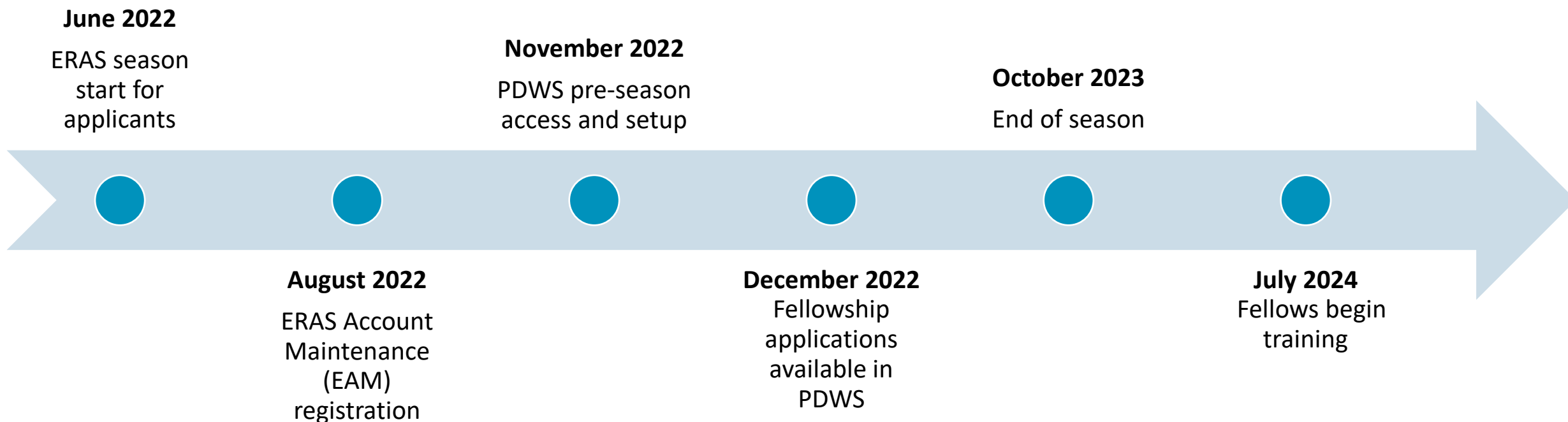

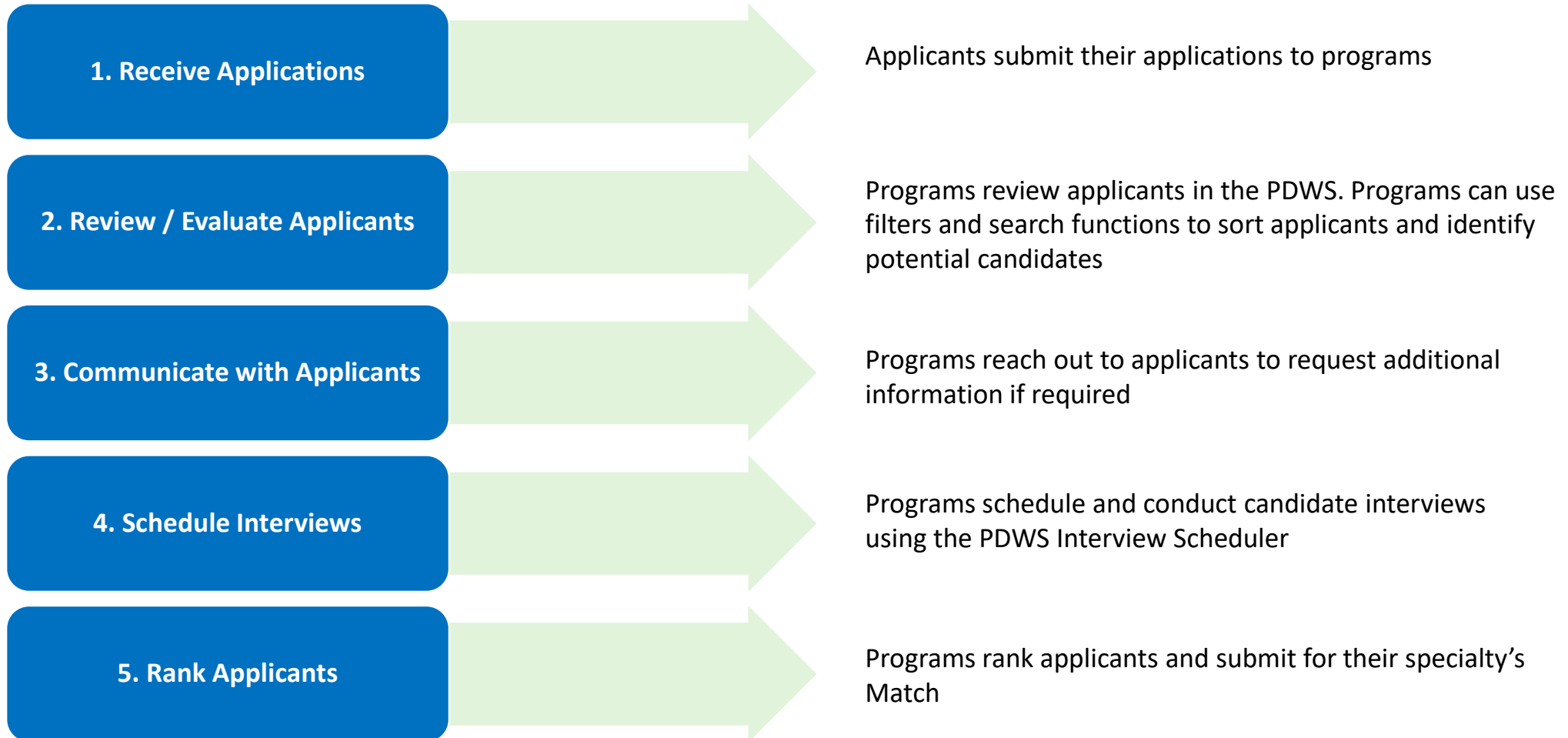

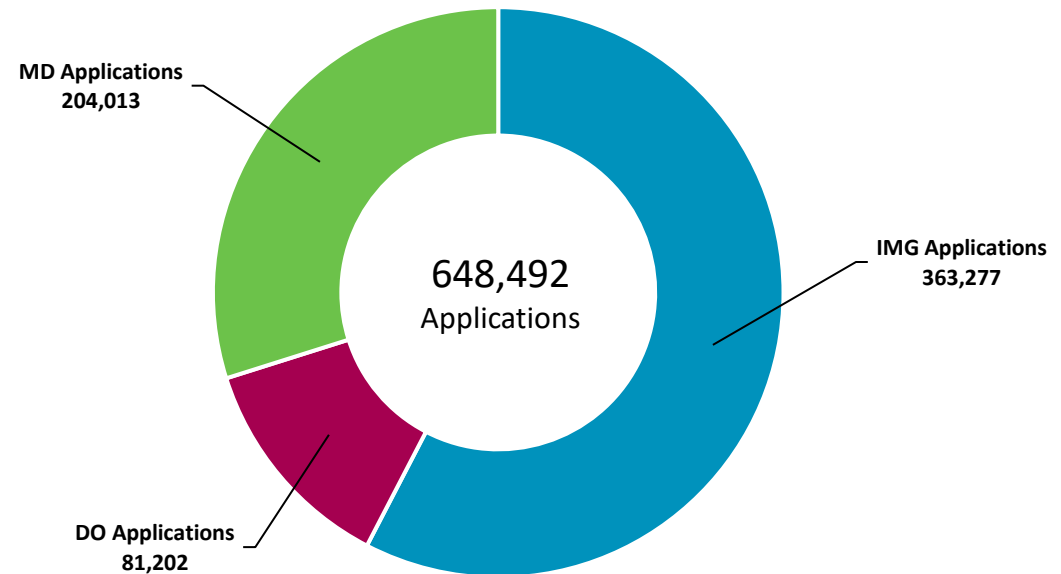
