

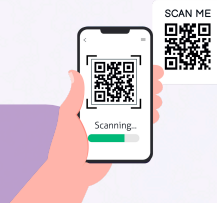
# For Live Captioning look for Koda

How to access Koda for your session

1. Find Koda QR code posters.



2. Scan the QR Code with your phone's camera.
